## Gospel Festival

Go where the people are. That’s how evangelism works. In French Quebec, many people can’t be found at home in the summer. They’re all out camping.

That’s why BLF Canada organised another family festival at Cedar Shade Campground. The campground is right near the Ontario/Quebec border, and most campers are French families.

Several local churches partnered with BLF in the event, contributing time, finances and committing to follow-up with the contacts that were made.

As usual, the campground was full on the last weekend of August. 11 artists/groups put on shows in the open-air amphitheatre. There was a better turn out than last year, with 75-100 people present for each event.



On Sunday afternoon, over 100 people came to the final Gospel Celebration. 23 people made a commitment to Jesus that day (some rededications, some conversions).

“It went great!” says BLF Canada director, Toe-Blake Roy. 

## Haiti update

In mid-September, BLF Canada partnered with “La Bible Parle,” who will be sending a mission team to Haiti next January.

BLF Canada has packed and shipped 50,000 Mini-Bibles (21 boxes total) and

200 solar powered recorders to a container in Laval. The shipment will depart for Haiti on October 29th, in order to arrive on time in January.

The solar powered recorders were donated by In Touch

Ministries, and come programmed with evangelistic messages from Chuck Swindoll.

BLF Canada is still raising funds to send 80 pastoral library packs to Haiti; along with a BLF mission team.


